

General Rules Governing the Use of the Trap Range

1. Shooters must stand behind the trap house and between the lines at all times when shooting.
2. When using the battery operated portable trap, it must be located in front of the trap house and set to throw the clay pigeons straight out or set to the correct right and left angles to be within the markers. When using a manual portable trap, both the trap and shooter must be directly in front of the trap house and the pigeons must be thrown between the markers.
3. When using a hand trap, the thrower and shooter must both be between the lines behind the trap house and throw birds only within the left and right markers.
4. No shooter is allowed more than one shell in the gun unless shooting doubles and then only two may be loaded.
5. Only one shooter on the squad is allowed to have a shell chambered and the action closed at a time unless taking part in a buddy shoot and then only two shall be allowed.
6. A squad shall consist of up to but not more than 5 shooters at one time.
7. Only one shooter is allowed to shoot at a clay pigeon unless taking part in a buddy shoot.
8. Only low brass shotgun shells of size 7 ½ or smaller shot are allowed.
9. Alcohol is not allowed at the trap range at any time.
10. The area is to be left clean of shotgun shells, boxes, papers, etc. when you are finished.
11. Always keep the muzzle of your gun pointed in a safe direction....Think safety.
