LET'S TALK TRASH AGAIN

Dumpsters and recycling are located at the East end of Camp A Road. This facility is primarily for wastes generated on the property by residents, campers, and day use. Use of the dumpsters is NOT a membership benefit.

The dumpsters are for household and camping wastes. The recycling totes are for clean glass, metal cans, plastic, paper, and cardboard. The recycling can all be mixed in the two totes. However, NO plastic shopping bags should be in the totes. They are considered trash and go in the dumpsters.

Returnable cans and bottles are collected at multiple locations and the proceeds help to fund our free kids' events.

So what should you do with the other items? Here is our recommendation:

- Large items, furniture and construction debris should be taken to the Scofield Transfer Station on Saunders Road in Stafford.
- •Metal scrap, old grills, and easy-up tent frames can be brought up to the shop and added to our metal pile.
- •Electronics can be taken to the ARC on West Main Street Road in Batavia. There will be a charge for this.
