

"Only one vehicle may be parked at a campsite area if room is available. All other, including guests, must be parked in a designated area."





Dumpsters and recycling are located at the East end of Camp A Road. This facility is primarily for wastes generated on the property by residents, campers, and day use. Use of the dumpsters is NOT a membership benefit.

There are the dumpsters for trash and totes for recycling. Please take notice of the two differences: recycling totes are for clean glass, metal cans, plastic, paper and cardboard. Trash dumpsters are for everyday trash like kitty litter, plastic shopping bags, garbage, etc.

Returnable cans and bottles are collected at multiple locations and the proceeds help to fund our free kids' events.

So what should you do with the other items? Here is our recommendation:

- Large items, furniture and construction debris should be taken to the Scofield Transfer Station on Saunders Road in Stafford.
- Metal scrap, old grills, and easy-up tent frames can be brought up to the shop and add ed to our metal pile.
- Electronics can be taken to the ARC on West Main Street Road in Batavia. There will be a charge for this.
