Pool Project Update:

The pool officially opened on July 3rd and we are averaging approximately 100 swimmers per day! Now, after 30 days, we finally have approval to operate the water slide starting Friday, August 2. We must have a lifeguard on duty when the slide is in operation.

Adult members are welcome to attend morning swim. everyday from 8:30am to 9:30am. This is when our staff is on the pool deck doing the routine maintenance. This is a great time for a quiet swim before we open for the day.

We are currently completing the certification and inspection necessary to allow night swimming. We must install emergency lights on the pool deck and post yet another warning sign. We would like to hold Adult swimming on weekend nights from 8:15 to 9:30pm. This swim time is over and above our budgeted time for staff. We are looking for a few "Responsible Persons" to oversee the nights sessions.

The qualifications for "Responsible Person" is as follows: Over 18 years of age, willing to be responsible for the safety of others in the pool, be available to cover some of the night swims on a regular schedule, and finally have a current CPR card. If you have these qualifications and are interested, see Angel, Mike, or leave your name and number with the Camp Store staff.

Pool House Project:

There are still a few loose ends and issues we are addressing on the building and septic systems too. This is all part of building and operating something this big and complicated.

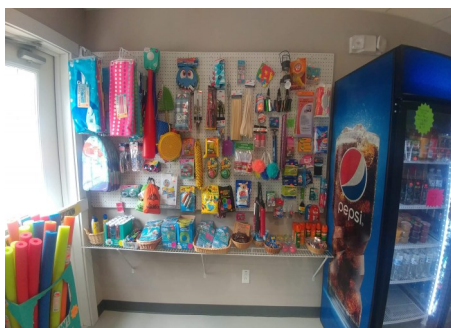
We are currently getting price quotes for the Laundry Room equipment. I'm not sure we will have the money for that until the next budget. Something to look forward to next year!
